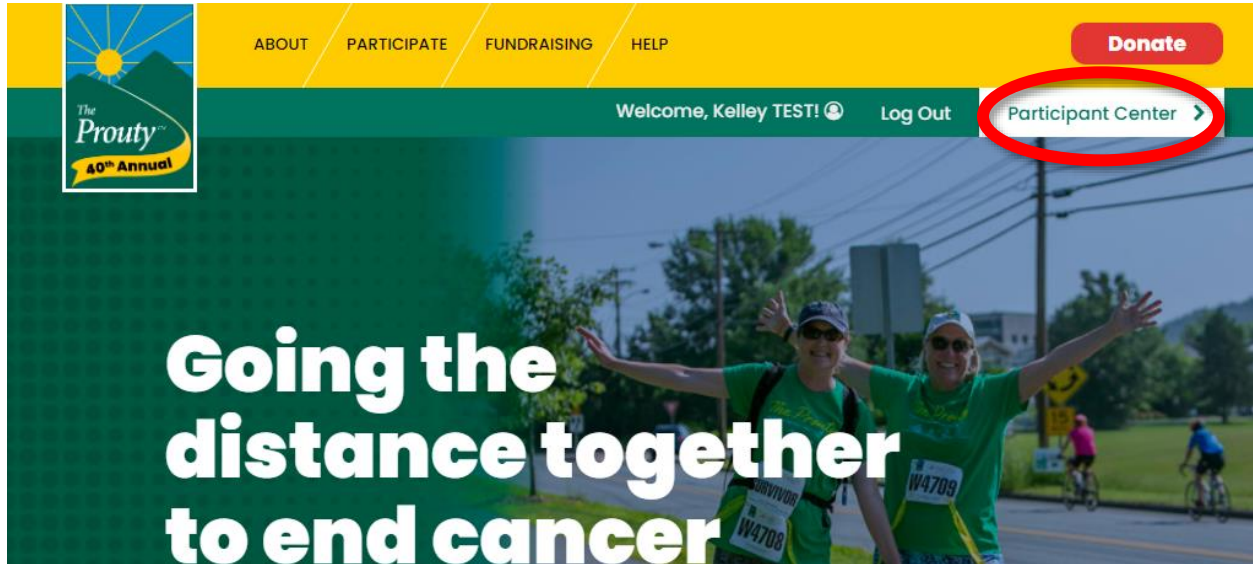


How to Setup Facebook Fundraising in your Participant Center

1. Go to www.TheProuty.org and log in to your account.
2. Click the button "Participant Center" on the green bar at the top of the page.



3. You should be on your home tab now. Scroll down to the blue box at the bottom of this webpage, under your Personal Page. Click the button "Fundraise on Facebook."

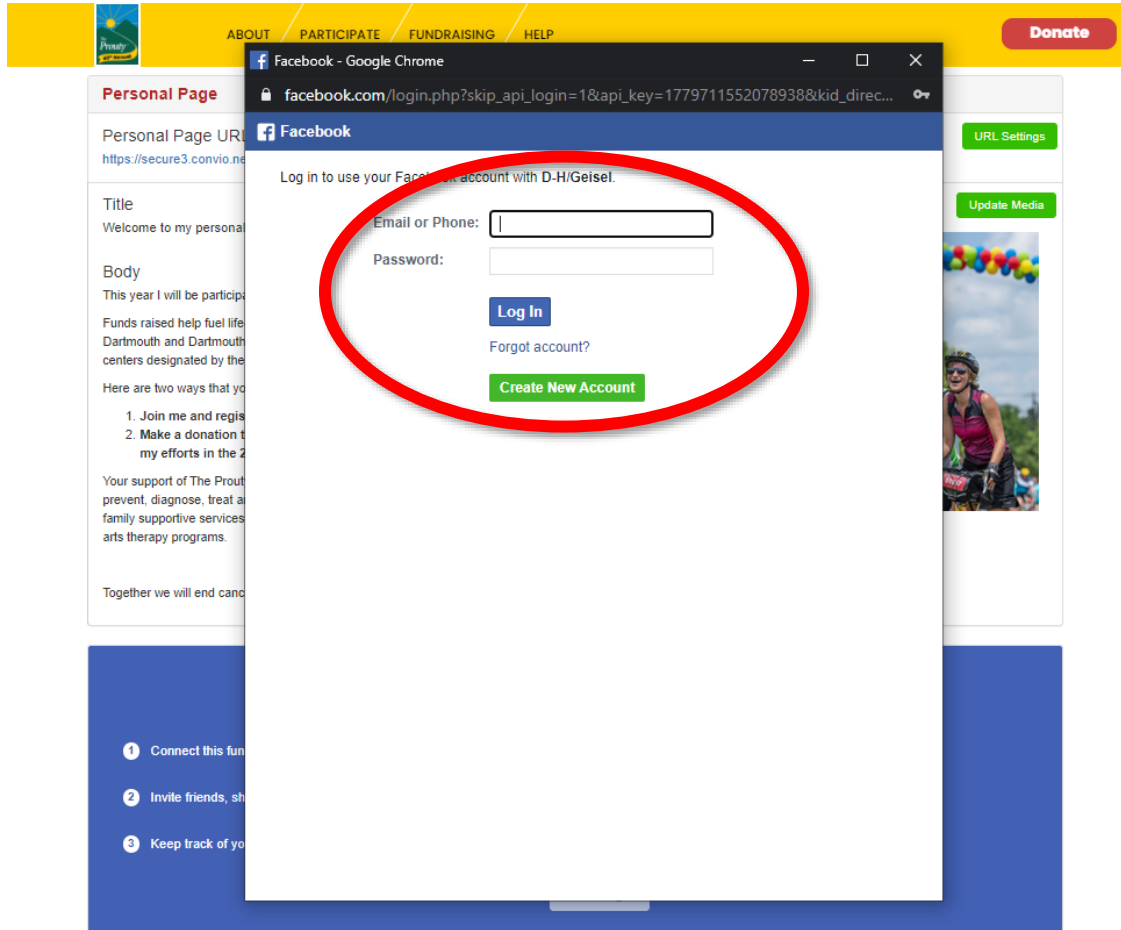

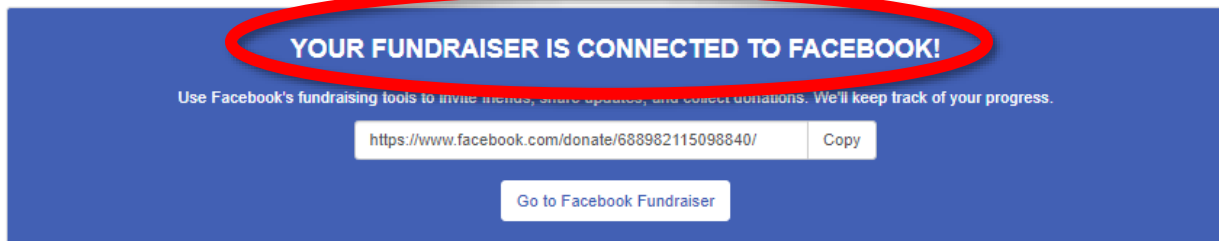
- 1 Connect this fundraiser to Facebook.

6. You will have to give D-H/Geisel approval to manager your fundraisers so that the Prouty online fundraising system syncs with the Facebook Fundraising system.
7. You will be taken back to your Prouty Participant Center. When you are connected the blue box will say, "Your Fundraiser is Connected to Facebook!"
