Fundraising Tips and Tricks

Personalize Your Fundraising Page

Add a photo to your personal fundraising page and share your Dartmouth Health Children's story. People are more likely to donate to your fundraising efforts when they know why you are fundraising for Dartmouth Health Children's.

Set a Fundraising Goal

It's okay to have a heroic fundraising goal. This will help motivate you and your potential donors. If you surpass your goal faster than the speed of light, you can always increase it.

Donate to Yourself

Be the first to donate to your fundraising efforts. This will kick off your fundraising and encourage others to donate as well.

Take Advantage of Company Matching Gifts

Many employers match funds you donate to charitable causes. You can request the necessary paperwork from your employer to get started.

Email, Email, Email

Email your family, friends, and colleagues and share why you are fundraising for Dartmouth Health Children's. Let them know why Dartmouth Health Children's matters to you. Start by emailing your close contacts as they are the ones most likely to contribute to your fundraising. Be sure to take advantage of the email templates that we have provided.

Follow Up

We are all busy and it is easy to forget you received an email asking for support. It is helpful to follow up with people who have talked to you about supporting your fundraising efforts. People usually need to be asked three times before they say yes and donate. A follow-up phone call is a great tool and lets everyone know how much Dartmouth Health Children's means to you.

Create Your Own Donor Incentives

Set your own donor prizes as an incentive to donate—it doesn't have to cost anything either. You could post a funny photo or video in honor of a donor, commit to a challenge if your fundraising goal is met, or deliver baked goods to anyone who donates over \$50. The possibilities are endless.

Managing your Participant Center and Fundraising Page

Edit Your Personal Fundraising Page*

- Log in to [chadhero.org](#).
- Click "PARTICIPANT CENTER" in the upper right-hand corner.
- Scroll down to where it says "Personal Page" on the right and click the blue button that says "Edit Content."
- Use the text box on this page to change the text on your fundraising page. Save your changes.
- Select the blue "Update Photo" button under where your fundraising page text displays in your participant center.
- Choose a new photo from your files to upload and select "Save/Upload." Your photo cannot be larger than 300 x 400 or 4MB.

Change Your Individual Fundraising Goal

- Log in to [chadhero.org](#).
- Click "PARTICIPANT CENTER" in the upper right-hand corner.
- Scroll down to where it says "Your Fundraising Progress" on the left.
- Select the blue button that says "Edit Goal."
- Enter your new fundraising goal and click "Save."

Share Your Personal Fundraising Page

- Visit [chadhero.org](#).
- Search for your name on the homepage under "SEARCH PARTICIPANTS."
- Click on your name. This will bring you to your personal fundraising page.
- From there, you can either copy the link in the search bar at the top of the page and share that or click on one of the icons under the word "SHARE" on the bottom right-hand side of your fundraising page to share your page through email or social media.

**Please note: Participants who are registered by someone else will have their own user names, passwords, and personal fundraising pages. This includes children registered by adults.*
